A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF DUBUQUE'S APPLICATION FOR FUNDING FROM THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S IOWA CLEAN AIR ATTAINMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS the Dubuque Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (DMATS) wishes to reduce congestion and emissions in Dubuque Metropolitan Area by replacing old diesel engines with clean diesel; and

WHEREAS the Newt Marine Towboats project will replace old diesel engine with EPA Tier 3 engines; and

WHEREAS the project is consistent with the DMATS 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan. Part of the overall goal is to protect and enhance the natural environment and support energy conservation and management. The above project will play a vital role in addressing enhance the natural environment by reduce emission in the region; and

WHEREAS the City of Dubuque wishes to seek funding by submitting an application, due October 01, 2017, for these improvements through the Iowa DOT Iowa Clean Air Attainment Program.
