## Call to Order

The DMATS Technical Advisory Board meeting was called to order by DMATS Technical Advisory Board Chair, Gus Psihoyos.

### <u>Review/Approve STBG funding requests for DMATS Federal Fiscal Year 2025-</u> 2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Ravada referred to the handout stating staff received four applications for STBG funds and all four projects met STBG guidelines. Ravada stated the four projects that were approved are,

- City of Dubuque 14<sup>th</sup> Street Overpass from Elm Street to Sycamore Street
- City of Dubuque US 20/NW Arterial Improvements from Old Highway Road to Crescent Ridge Road
- Dubuque County North Cascade Resurfacing east of Swiss Valley to Edval Lane
- Dubuque County Skyline Road resurfacing from US 151 to US 61

Ravada stated all projects are within the budget for STBG funds. Ravada requested the board to approve projects so staff can program projects within the TIP.

Motion by Weber, second by McPherson to recommend approval to the DMATS Policy Board the STBG funding requests for DMATS Federal Fiscal Year 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The motion passed unanimously.

#### **Discussion on The Ports of Eastern Iowa**

Ravada stated recently counties received a resolution from Sinkler requesting to form a port authority where the counties would be the members of the board. Ravada stated Sinkler feels by the counties along the Mississippi forming a port authority, it will allow them to lobby in Washington DC. Ravada stated the Corp of Engineers stated even with a port authority there will be no more funding. Ravada informed the board that staff checked with other boards along the Mississippi to get their opinions and what they are doing for their ports and counties are looking into what forming a port authority would look like for them.

Cavanagh stated he would like to know what kind of funding could potentially be available and what are the downsides of forming a port authority.

Resnick asked if the group potentially formed is not an advocacy group to secure funding, then he poses the question of what is the purpose of forming a group.

Discussion followed.

Board members would like more information on forming a port authority and what that would do for the DMATS area.

#### Presentation from United Way about getting involved with Over the Edge program

Wiedemann addressed the board and gave them information on all the benefits of United Way within the community and how community support helps raise funds for programs within the community. Wiedemann encouraged board members to participate in over the edge program and if not participating to support it monetarily.
