## <u>Review/Approve the minutes and receive and file the secretarial notes from the</u> <u>Thursday, May 8, 2025 meeting</u>

Motion by Resnick, second by Farber to approve the minutes and receive and file the secretarial notes from the Thursday, May 8, 2025, DMATS Policy Board meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

## **<u>Review/Approve Amendment to DMATS Federal Fiscal Year 2025-2028</u></u> <u>Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)</u>**

Motion by Resnick, second by Cavanagh to open the public hearing. The motion passed unanimously. The public hearing was opened at 12:07 p.m.

Ravada stated the amendment to the TIP was for the Iowa Department of Transportation US 20 Farley to Swiss Valley pavement rehab project. The project is starting earlier than expected, therefore the funds were moved into FY25.

Motion by Farber, second by Resnick to approve the Amendment to DMATS Federal Fiscal Year 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The motion passed unanimously.

### <u>Review/Recommend draft DMATS Federal Fiscal Year 2026-2029 Transportation</u> <u>Improvement Program (TIP)</u>

Ravada referred to the TIP stating the projects included in the TIP,

- City of Dubuque STREETS Project Implementation
- City of Dubuque STREETS Phase II Project Implementation
- City of Dubuque 14<sup>th</sup> Street overpass
- City of Dubuque US Highway 20, Northwest Arterial Intersection

- Dubuque County North Cascade Resurfacing
- Dubuque County Skyline Road Resurfacing
- City of Asbury, Asbury Road and Hales Mill Roundabout

Ravada reviewed the projects and balance sheets. Ravada stated the board has 30 days to review and inform staff of any changes that need to be made to the TIP.

Motion by Farber, second by Resnick to approve the draft DMATS Federal Fiscal Year 2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The motion passed unanimously.

### **Review/Approve Fiscal Year 2026 Passenger Transportation Plan (PTP)**

Studier stated the PTP has been submitted to the DOT and no changes were made.

Discussion followed.

Motion by Cavanagh, second by Resnick to close the public hearing. The motion passed unanimously. The public hearing was closed at 12:21 p.m.

Motion by Farber, second by Resnick to approve the Fiscal Year 2026 Passenger Transportation Plan (PTP). The motion passed unanimously.

#### **Review/Recommend release of Transportation Alternative application with changes**

Ravada stated technical board suggested we defer the release of the TAP applications until FY26 so the more funds are available.

Motion by Cavanagh, second by Resnick to approve deferring the release of the Transportation Alternative applications with changes until FY26. The motion passed unanimously.
