### Review/Approve Final DMATS Federal Fiscal Year 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

# <u>Discussion on the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) discretionary grant</u> program

Ravada stated staff attending a webinar with Federal Highway and US DOT on this subject. This is a new federal grant rolling out. Ravada stated first a safety plan needs to be in place for the RPA and MPO areas before applying for the grant. Ravada stated there will be \$1 billion dollars available yearly and it will be highly competitive. It was suggested to take a regional approach when applying.

Ravada stated the SS4A funding supports local initiatives for safety and to prevent deaths and serious injuries on roads and streets. Ravada stated the MPO does not have a safety plan, therefore the first step is to create a safety plan which includes basic roadway safety, a safe system approach and complete streets. Ravada stated applying as an MPO we will have a better chance at receiving funding.

Discussion followed.

Ravada informed the board that staff had discussions with the City of Dubuque, City of Asbury and Dubuque County on how they would like to proceed with the first part of this grant, which is planning funds. All were all in agreement to apply together as an MPO to get more funding for the implementation. Ravada informed the board the match for this grant will be 20 percent.
