On Thursday, February 14, 2019 at 12:00 p.m., the Dubuque Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (DMATS) will hold a Public Hearing for approval of amendment to FFY 2019-2022 Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP).

The public is invited to submit their input. The Public Hearing will be held at East Central Intergovernmental Association, Community room, 7600 Commerce Park, Dubuque, Iowa. This facility is accessible under the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act. DMATS receives federal funding and may not discriminate against anyone on the basis of race, color, or national origin, according to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
