Call to Order

The DMATS Technical Advisory Board meeting was called to order by DMATS Technical Advisory Board Chair, Gus Psihoyos.

Review/Recommend Draft Fiscal Year 2024 DMATS Transportation Planning Work Program (TPWP)

Ravada stated the work staff will be focusing on is the short and long range transportation plans, STREETS project and the Dubuque County BUILD grant administration. Ravada stated the Board has a month to review and recommend any changes.

Motion by Schiesl, second by Duba to recommend approval to the DMATS Policy Board the draft fiscal year 2024 DMATS Transportation Planning Work Program (TPWP). The motion passed unanimously.

Review/Recommend resolution to submit FY 2024 Illinois Competitive Special Planning Research (SPR) application for ITS Improvement Assessment Plan for Interstate Bridge Detour Routes on the Mississippi River

Ravada stated the resolution states the MPO will apply for SPR grant funds in partnership with the City of East Dubuque to assist with funding of its improvement assessment plan for interstate bridge detour routes on the Mississippi river. Ravada informed the board the STREETS project will cover the Iowa side, although they are not able to cover the Illinois and Wisconsin bridges. So therefore, if the MPO receives the SPR funds, the MPO will be able to tie in the bridges to the STREETS project.

Discussion followed.

Motion by Duba, second by Schiesl to recommend approval to the DMATS Policy Board the resolution to submit FY 2024 Illinois Competitive Special Planning Research (SPR) application for ITS Improvement Assessment Plan for Interstate Bridge Detour Routes on the Mississippi River. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on Safe Streets and Road for All (SS4A) grant scope of services for INTRANS

Ravada went over a draft scope of service outline with the board members. Ravada stated the consultants, InTrans will be working on data collection, data analysis, staffing, and budget. MPO staff with work on public input meetings. Ravada stated initially staff were thinking of completing the plan within 14 months. However, Federal highway stated it should take at least 2 years and if plans are submitting before the two year timeline Federal highway will not look at the plan as they feel the plan is not complete.
