WHEREAS the Regional Planning affiliation 8 (RPA 8) wishes to reduce congestion and emissions in RPA 8 region by reducing delay at intersection: and

WHEREAS the roundabout project at Manufacturing Drive & S 19th Street in the City of Clinton will help to reduce delays; and

WHEREAS the project is consistent with the RPA 8 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan. Part of the overall goal is to Reduce congestion on primary freight corridors. The above project is on a freight corridor in the city of Clinton which will play a vital role in reducing overall time on the corridor; and
