OVERVIEW

East Central Intergovernmental Association (ECIA) and the Institute for Transportation at Iowa State University (InTrans) are developing a transportation safety action plan to identify issues and eliminate fatalities and serious injuries for all roadway users - pedestrians, bicyclists, transit users, and drivers.

With community input the plan will identify and prioritize infrastructure projects and policies to address safety issues. The plan will map out strategies for funding and implementing the plan's recommendations.
