On Thursday, June 25, 2020 at 9:00 a.m., the Regional Planning Affiliation 8 (RPA 8) will hold a Public Hearing for approval of Final Federal Fiscal Year 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), Final Fiscal Year 2021 RPA 8 Title VI Non-Discrimination Program Plan, Final Fiscal Year 2021 RPA 8 Limited English Proficiency (LEP) Plan, Fiscal Year 2021 Passenger Transportation Plan (PTP) and a Final FY 2021 Public Involvement Policy Plan (PIP)..

The public is invited to submit their input. The Public Hearing will be held at East Central Intergovernmental Association., Community room, 7600 Commerce Park, Dubuque, Iowa. This facility is accessible under the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act. RPA 8 receives federal funding and may not discriminate against anyone on the basis of race, color, or national origin, according to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. For more information or to obtain a Title VI Complaint form, call 563-556-4166. RPA 8 is open to all individuals regardless of disability. Any person with a disability requiring a reasonable accommodation to participate in this meeting should contact the RPA 8 office at (563) 556-4166 at least two business days prior to the scheduled meeting. The RPA 8 office will be closed to public due to COVID -19. Individuals who need to attend RPA 8 meeting physically should get in touch with RPA 8 staff one day before the meeting to updated staff on their attended. Staff will be asking questions before providing approval to attend the meeting.

The TIP is prepared and adopted each year and contains projects for the coming four fiscal years. The Title VI Non-Discrimination Program Plan is designed to address title VI regulations within RPA 8 area and Limited English Proficiency plan is designed to address how RPA 8 will accommodate non-English-speaking population in planning and decision-making process. The PIP is developed in hopes that it will promote and encourage citizen involvement in the decision-making process. The PTP is designed to provide needs-based project justification for all transit programs within the DMATS and RPA 8.

The Final FFY 2021-2024 TIP, Final FY 2021 Title VI Non-Discrimination Program Plan, Final FY 2021 Limited English Proficiency plan, PTP Plan and Final FY 2021 Public Involvement Policy Plan is currently available for review at the office of the Regional Planning Affiliation 8, ECIA, 7600 Commerce Park, Dubuque, Iowa.
