Ravada stated the existing Regional Planning Affiliation funding is distributed based on population and regional needs. The regional needs are assessed based on the ratio of the number of counties in the RPA out of the statewide total counties. The recommended change to funding distribution is the change the regional planning needs to a ratio of the total non-MPO land area of RPA out of the statewide total non-MPO land area.

Ravada stated if approved, that will give our RPA an increase of \$1,078.00. Ravada informed the board that DOT would like a decision from all RPAs within Iowa.

Motion by Lindner, second by Brooke, to recommend to the RPA 8 Policy Board approval of the reviewing of Iowa's Distribution Formulas for RPA Transportation Planning Funds in Iowa. The motion passed unanimously.

### **Review/Approve Urbanized Area Boundaries within RPA 8**

The board asked for verification on what the 2010 boundary includes. Ravada suggested the board go with the 2010 boundaries.

Vick stated the 2010 boundary areas do not cover their whole area.
