

REGIONAL PLANNING AFFILIATION 8 (RPA 8) POLICY COMMITTEE RPA 8 RESOLUTION 2022-1

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF A SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) GRANT APPLICATION FOR A COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY ACTION PLAN.

WHEREAS Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Discretionary Grant Program is designed to support planning, infrastructure, behavioral, and operational initiatives to prevent death and serious injury on roads and streets involving all roadway users, including pedestrians; bicyclists; public transportation, personal conveyance, and micromobility users; motorists; and commercial vehicle operators; and

WHEREAS the United States Department of Transportation provides SS4A grants on a competitive basis for planning and implementation of projects prevent deaths and serious injuries on roads and streets; and

WHEREAS the federal funding share for SS4A projects is 80% of the proposed cost of eligible projects; and

WHEREAS the Regional Planning Affiliation 8 (RPA 8) is the transportation planning agency for Clinton, Delaware, Dubuque and Jackson counties; and

WHEREAS the RPA 8 Policy Committee believes that development of a comprehensive safety action plan will help the organization achieve its long-term objective of reducing transportation related injuries and deaths; and

WHEREAS RPA 8 will be the lead applicant with support from the cities and counties; and

WHEREAS Iowa Department of Transportation, and Iowa State University Institute for Transportation (InTrans) will be Partners on the project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

That the RPA 8 Policy Committee authorizes submittal of a SS4A application for
development of a comprehensive safety action plan, and that the RPA 8 will participate in
the development of the comprehensive safety action plan in accordance with its designated
responsibility, and will participate in funding of the project by providing the 20% local match
