On Thursday, April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 8:30 a.m., the Regional Planning Affiliation 8 (RPA 8) will hold a Public Hearing for approval of amended final Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) for FFY 2019-2022 and Draft FY 2020 Transportation Planning Work Program (TPWP).
